

Millville Board of Health
Minutes of the Meeting
April 18, 2007

A meeting of the Board of Health was held on April 18, 2007 at 6:30PM, in the Board of Health Office, Longfellow Municipal Center, 8 Central Street, Millville, MA.

The Meeting was called to order at 6:35PM.

The Board signed Minutes of the Meeting from April 4, 2007.

The Board reviewed the Mercury Disposal Regulations; T. Houle made a motion to accept the regulations as written, P. Tympanick seconded; motion passed unanimously.

The Board reviewed the Massage Therapy Regulations; T. Houle made a motion to accept the regulations as written, P. Tympanick seconded; motion passed unanimously.

The Board reviewed the Environmental Tobacco Smoke Regulations; T. Houle made a motion to accept the regulations as written, P. Tympanick seconded; motion passed unanimously.

The Board reviewed the Body Art Establishment Regulations; T. Houle made a motion to accept the regulations as written, P. Tympanick seconded; motion passed unanimously.

The Board reviewed the Septic Plan requirement requesting all septic plans to be stamped and signed by a Massachusetts Registered Professional Engineer, or a Massachusetts Registered Sanitarian with a co-stamp indicating review of the plan by an engineer, or Registered Land Surveyor. This is a common requirement most surrounding towns have already adopted. The Board feels this regulation will help protect the homeowner, and agree to adopt this regulation. T. Houle made a motion to accept the regulation as written, P. Tympanick seconded; motion passed unanimously.

T. Houle signed the form "request for legal services" asking Town Counsel to review these regulations.

The Nuisance Regulations and Tobacco Sale to Minor Regulations will be reviewed at the next Board of Health meeting.

The Board Members plan on attending the Stormwater meeting on April 25, at 6PM. Unfortunately, due to the conflict, none of the Board members will be able to attend the Blackstone Valley Regional Board of Health Meeting.

The problems at 56 Main Street were discussed. D. Stanley, Amy Sutherland, along with Police Officer Sampson inspected on April 16, 2007. They found a dismantled bulldozer and two dumpsters within the wet land zone. Hydraulic fluid was observed leaking into the ground from one dumpster, and the bulldozer. D. Stanley will write up the violations, letters will be sent to Mr. Mike Pare stating the violations of the State Sanitary Code, and requesting attendance at a BOH hearing. D. Stanley's report will be included with the letters. T. Houle requested Mr. Pare's \$75.00 for his installer license is returned to him. T. Houle stated the septic system will need to be removed as it was installed illegally, and never inspected.

The complaint at 66 Ironstone St. was reviewed. D. Stanley inspected and found there was not enough progress made on the clean up. A ticket was served to Mrs. Barbrie giving 21 days for compliance.

The joint meeting to discuss EDS is set for April 24, 2007 at 6PM. Gerry Labonte questioned the need of his attendance. T. Houle stated he would like Mr. Labonte to attend if possible.

The Board will review the sample cease and desist order at the next BOH meeting.

The Board reviewed and approved a memo to be sent to the Board of Selectman and the Finance Committee requesting an increase in the line item for the BOH Secretary, with documentation supporting this request.

T. Houle signed the septic permit for the Senior Center.

T. Houle stated all perc requests/inspections should be called in to Lenny Izzo, as Mike Graf stated at the last meeting he has taken on another job and is very busy.

Keys for two file cabinets were provided to the Board Members. Blackstone Lock is providing an estimate to lock the remaining file cabinet.

Vouchers were signed; folders were reviewed.

Meeting adjourned at 7:30PM.
