

Millville Board of Health
Minutes of the Meeting
February 6, 2008

A meeting of the Board of Health was held on February 6, 2008 at 6:30 p.m., in the Board of Health Office, Longfellow Municipal Center, 8 Central Street, Millville, MA.

The Meeting was called to order at 6:31 p.m.

The minutes from January 16, 2007 were approved and signed.

Donna Morris from Millville Heights asked the BOH if blood pressure/vital sign checks could be conducted by the VNA on a regular basis. This would raise the cost of the VNA contract; the funds are not available for the next fiscal year. L. Cameron will call the Senior Center Director to inquire where seniors can obtain these checks.

Central Mass Disposal revised the pick-up day for Chestnut Hill Road - from Albee Road to Lincoln Street. These houses will be picked up on Tuesday mornings. This was posted on cable and the Town web site. In addition, letters were sent to the residents involved.

D. Stanley would like to review the nuisance regulations before they are sent to Town Counsel. The Board will review the new dumpster regulations and animal regulations to discuss at the next meeting.

The equipment purchased through the Region 2 grant was received.

L. Cameron will conduct the one tobacco inspection required for the mini-grant.

The Board approved the betterment loan applications for Butero and Laflamme.

A memo from the Finance Committee was reviewed; the BOH will meet with them in April.

The document for inter-municipal aid for public health was reviewed and signed. The Board questioned if Blackstone has been included in the agreement.

Hauler licenses were signed.

The proposal from Tata & Howard was reviewed. This will be put out to bid.

D. Stanley made a motion, seconded by D. Ciccarelli to grant the local upgrade request for 21 Quaker St., the septic plans were approved.

The septic plans for 85 Lincoln St. will be reviewed by the Health Agent.

A letter was received from the Millville Elementary School; D. Stanley will inspect to see if all requirements have been met.

A letter from CMG Environmental was reviewed.

D. Stanley will mount the AED cabinet provided by Region 2. The rate for the AED/CPR class was higher than quoted; the BOH will absorb the additional cost. D. Stanley will confirm the cost with the instructor.

The March 5, 2008 BOH meeting will be rescheduled due to training conflicts.

Richard Hurteau is questioning the "home installation only" limitation put on his installer license. The Board would like additional information from Mr. Hurteau.

The Douglas BOH asked if Millville has regulations for outside wood stoves. This will be researched. D. Stanley suggested Bellingham may have current regulations in place.

D. Stanley made a motion, seconded by D. Ciccarelli to add information to the food permit application concerning hiring workers in the United States illegally. This will also be added to the permits.

Complaints were reviewed; 9 Quaker St. – overflowing septic; D. Stanley to inspect. 46 Hope St. – mold problem, D. Stanley contacted Ron Rheault to correct problem.

T. Houle inspected 69 Hope St.

Vouchers were signed; folders were reviewed.

Meeting adjourned at 8:10 p.m.
