The Board is meeting to review the engineering plans and work performed at the site on Lincoln Street. Mr. Pawlowski states that the work was not performed according to the engineered plans.

Mr. Pawlowski would like the berm near the mailbox feathered in towards the yard. He was told that the berm would be one that could be driven over. He also feels it is a trip hazard for his family members. Various options to resolve the problem were discussed among the parties including bringing in fill to raise the side of the berm.

Mr. Pawlowski also has serious concerns about the condition of the drainage land. He states that the Town has taken far more land than the easement allowed for and that the stones used are not according to plan. He feels the Town is trespassing at least 45 ft onto his property and the drainage isn't flowing in the direction that it should. Also, there aren't any staked hay bales installed, according to the plan. The Board members agreed that there does appear to be problems with the work.

The Board will reconvene at the Longfellow Municipal Center to open its Regular Meeting and will discuss this matter further at that time.
