



Millville Recycling Guide



MATERIAL COLLECTED

HOW TO PREPARE IT

WHAT NOT TO INCLUDE

METAL

Steel & aluminum
Food & beverage cans
and lids

rinse clean to prevent smell or bugs.
labels ok.
place in bin.

NO scrap metal, aerosol cans,
paint cans or propane tanks,
NO aluminum foil or trays.

GLASS

Bottles & jars
All color & sizes

rinse clean to prevent smell or bugs.
labels ok.
place carefully in bin.

NO light bulbs, window or auto
glass, pyrex, ceramics, mirrors,
drinking glasses, or vases.
DO NOT BREAK GLASS.

PLASTICS 1-7

Number found on bottom
of container.

rinse clean to prevent smell or bugs.
flatten to save space.
Place in bin

NO bottles used for
hazardous material such as antifreeze
or motor oil
NO styrofoam (packing peanuts, etc.)

PAPER

Newspaper with inserts,
junk mail, magazines,
catalogs, phonebooks,
soft cover books.

do not tie with string or rope,
place in paper grocery bags
beside bin or place paper in bin.

No plastic coated paper or boxes,
carbon paper, tissues, napkins,
paper cups or plates.

CORRUGATED

Boxes and corrugated

do not tie with string or rope,
cut or flatten into two (2) foot
by two (2) foot sizes.

NO food residue or soiled
corrugated,
NO pizza boxes- *place in trash*
NO waxed boxes.

Set your bin at the curb by 7AM on the day of pickup

A clearly marked bag or bin may be used for additional recyclables (separate bags/bins for each material).

A 30-gallon barrel marked clearly with a recycling sticker can be used for plastics only. Stickers may be picked up at the Millville Board of Health office Monday – Thursday 8:30AM – 2:00PM.
