## MILLVILLE STORM WARNING INFORMATION

Dear Millville Residents:

Please know Millville Officials continue to monitor weather reports along with updates from the Massachusetts Emergency Management Association as we prepare for the major snow/wind event expected into the area tomorrow on Thursday, January 4<sup>th</sup>. Our area is anticipating 14 to 18 inches of snow, wind gusts up to 40 mph and freezing temperatures with negative double digit wind chill factors.

This is being categorized as a **MAJOR** Storm Event, with anticipated power and telephone outages that will likely affect our residents over an extended 72 hour period. Our local Emergency Management Team is preparing in advance to keep our community as safe as possible throughout the severe weather.

Town Hall operations at 290 Main Street will be **CLOSED** tomorrow as will the Blackstone Millville Regional School District, Millville Senior Center and Library. Also, starting tomorrow at **9:00 AM**, the Millville Elementary School Gymnasium will be open for anyone who may need Emergency Shelter. **Should any person or family have an emergency, require transportation to the Emergency Shelter or need immediate assistance during the storm please do not hesitate to contact our Police Department at (508) 883-3117.**

**Please stay off the roads and safe in your homes throughout the storm. Remember to bring pets into the safety of your home and do not let them venture outside without a lead because they can become quickly disoriented and lose their way in blizzard conditions.**

Electric and telephone companies are mobilizing with rotating shifts and external crews to address outages.
