

**Millville Board of Health
Minutes of the Meeting
August 17, 2016**

A meeting of the Board of Health was held on August 17, 2016 at 10 Central Street, Police Station Conference Room, Millville, MA. The Meeting was called to order at 6:00 PM.

Board of Health Members:

D. Ciccarelli motioned to open meeting. ^{C. Robinson} ~~B. Marks~~ seconded the motion, motioned passed.

Dishington Landscaping Construction:

Nathan Dishington, owner of Dishington Landscaping Construction, comes before the Board as a new applicant for a septic installer's license. Mr. Dishington could not produce (3) current permits from other towns. An installer's test was administered and Mr. Dishington successfully passed. He also supplied the liability/workmen's comp. insurance and a hoisting license by a different person – this person will be excavating the property. The application is otherwise complete.

D. Ciccarelli stated that he wanted Mr. Dishington aware that the hoister listed on the application is the only person who can perform the excavation. Mr. Dishington stated that he was aware already.

D. Ciccarelli motions to approve the septic installer's license. C. Robinson seconded the motion – motion passed unanimously.

102 & 112 Chestnut Hill Road – Susan Gray:

Susan Gray sent a letter of request to the Board of Health that was received on August 11, 2016 to extend the perc tests on the two lots for another two years. The last extension was granted on August 20, 2014.

D. Ciccarelli motions to grant the perc tests on lots 102 & 112 Chestnut Hill Road for another two years pending inspection of the lots and that they have remained undisturbed.

4 Hurteau Road – Building addition to septic system:

The property owners are constructing a third bay to their garage and the distance to the leaching field falls just under the 20-foot allowance. The outer garage wall to septic is about 2.5 feet closer than allowed. The Board felt that this distance was not an issue and just wanted to let the owners know not to drive any heavy equipment on the property.

VNA – Contract:

D. Ciccarelli motioned to approve the VNA contract. C. Robinson seconded the motion – motioned approved and the contract was signed.

Food Permits – Millville Community Day

D. Ciccarelli motioned to waive the fees for the food permits on this event day. B. Marks seconded the motion – motioned passed. (Robert Marks voted remotely by telephone). C. Robinson abstained from voting due to her involvement with the Centennial Committee.
