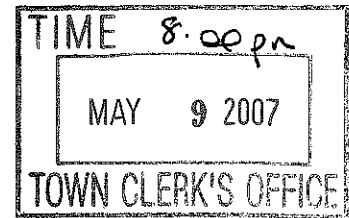

The Town officials meet with Emergency Preparedness Consultant, Ken Gikas, representing Worcester County Region 2, Department of Public Health. Ken is here to discuss the Emergency Dispensing Site (EDS).

Ken explains that the preliminary stages of work in writing the Emergency Dispensing Site Plan have taken place. The Millville Elementary School will serve as the Town's EDS in the event of a town-wide illness, large-scale vaccination, or natural disaster. He is assisting the Board of Health in completing the Plan.

The parties discuss the NIMS requirements and review and discuss the Organizational Chart that needs to be completed as soon as possible. The Town will be receiving reverse 911 free of charge through June 2008, to be installed at the Police Station this June.

On a Motion by Karin Furno and second by Charlie Poulin, the members vote to allow the Change Order Request.


On a Motion by Karin Furno and second by Charlie Poulin, the members vote to authorize the Chairperson to sign.


On a Motion by Charlie Poulin and second by Karin Furno, the members vote to adjourn the Meeting at 7:15 p.m.
