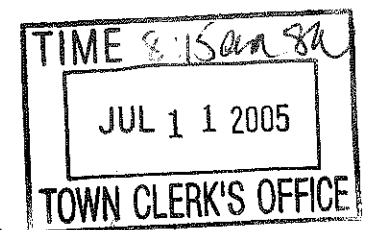


**TOWN OF MILLVILLE

Resident, Norman Thuot, 25 Ironstone St. wanted the Board of Selectmen informed that the traffic on Snow St. has now increased due the bridge construction. The Board of Selectmen discussed changing the speed limit on Snow St. to 15 miles per hour. The new limits will be posted for safety reasons. The Board also agreed that West St. should be changed to 25 miles per hour.

On a motion made by Brian Dicks, seconded by Tom Petrowicz, the Board voted unanimously to post the speed limit at 15 miles per hour for Snow and 25 miles per hour on West. St.

## **EXECUTIVE SECRETARY REPORT**

Executive Secretary wanted the BOS to correct the appointment of the Fire Chief that was made at the last meeting. It needs to be changed from a one-year to a three-year term.

On a motion made with Brian Dicks, seconded by Tom Petrowicz, the Board voted to change the appointment term of the Fire Chief from one-term to a three-year terms. Member, Ken Gikas abstained from the vote.

The BOS voted in 1981 for a Mutual Aid Agreement, but the minutes cannot be found to affirm that so the BOS need to revote.

On a motion made by Paul Savage, seconded by Tom Petrowicz, the BOS voted unanimously to approve and accept the Massachusetts General Law Section 48-59A for the Mutual Aid Agreement.

The landfill project is still on target as far as a completion date. There will be shaping material that will be coming in the next two weeks.

The Veteran Agent position has not been filled. There are four names that Sue received and she will be contacting them. This position will be posted on cable.

The BOS are still working on the water issue at the elementary school. The BOS is looking to hire a Certified Water Operator but no decision has been made yet.

The librarian will be leaving and the position will be advertised on cable.

There is no update about to the STRAP grant for the Lincoln St project.
