Animal Control:

There was a meeting about the animal control officer being an intermunicipal position throughout surrounding towns. This negotiation is still ongoing.

Intermunicipal agreement with Planning Board and Town Planner:

The Board was informed that there has been difficulty filling the shared planning services for the Planning Board and Town Planner for the surrounding towns. There will be meetings to rethink this arrangement.

Audit and Management Letter:

The Board of Selectmen have received the draft of the FY2020 audit and received the management letter. The final report will be provided to the Board of Selectmen at a future meeting.

Tax Classification Hearing:
