Memorial Park

John Hadley mentioned that the original survey of fire station (1970) was never recorded into state records. New survey needs signatures before it can be submitted to the State to be in compliance with a grant already received. Ms. Maloney will coordinate with Mr. Hadley to sign. Mr. Mullaly brought the motion to approve, seconded by Mr. Coupe. Motion passed unanimously.

Shared Planner Discussion

Ms. Maloney stated that discussion of how Millville can fund their share of this position was going to be addressed by the Board of Selectmen at an upcoming December meeting.
