

**COMMONWEALTH OF MASSACHUSETTS
TOWN OF MILLVILLE
RESULTS OF SPECIAL TOWN MEETING
MONDAY, JUNE 30, 2014 – 6:30 P.M.**

The Special Town Meeting was called to order by Les Davis, Town Moderator at 6:35 pm. Since 156 registered voters were present the quorum requirement was met.

All present then rose and faced the flag and recited the Pledge of Allegiance.

Mr. Davis relayed to those present word from our State Rep. Kevin Kuros, the good news that the State has increased the Transportation Reimbursement that the cities and towns will receive. Statewide that means an increase for \$53 million to \$70 million.

The Moderator than made a motion to dispense with the reading of the warrant and this motion was duly seconded.

Because some the money that was being voted upon was coming from the Capitol Planning Account, Mr. Davis told the assembly that there would need to be a 2/3rds Majority to pass the Article.

Selectman Chair, Roland Barrett made a motion to move in the words of the Article and this was seconded by Selectman Jennifer Dean-Wing.

Mr. Davis asked that those voting in favor of the Article to stand. More than 90% of voters present stood.


He then asked those opposed to stand and under 12 people stood.
