Meeting Minutes: Friday September 24, 2021

## Meeting Time is 1000 AM at the Chestnut Hill Community Hall

The meeting was held at the Chestnut Hill Community Hall with J. Hadley, B. Dakai, N. Thuot, and Elaine Ethier present, absent was Normand Gamache.
